Rationale

We believe that our school is special and that all pupils who attend are part of our collective family, for which we are all responsible. In the same way that teaching, and support staff wear clothes that are appropriate for the purpose, we believe that pupils should wear a uniform that is practical and attractive, and which signifies their membership of the school. We would like all pupils to follow our guidelines and ask for support from parents/carers to make this work. We respect the cultural background of all our pupils and acknowledge that there may be some exceptions to these guidelines; these would need to be agreed between parents and the Head Teacher. We also acknowledge equal opportunities based on gender.

Indoor Clothing

For everyday wear, pupils are expected to follow the dress code of Stone St Mary's CE Primary School which is plain grey tailored trousers/ shorts or a skirt/pinafore dress, teamed with a white shirt, blouse or polo shirt, and a green cardigan, jumper or sweatshirt. Green and white checked dresses are optional during warmer weather. Socks or tights should be black, white, or grey. Items showing the school logo are available to purchase from our school's Arbor App or via the Arbor Website <https://login.arbor.sc/>.

Hair

- Hair should be tied back with a plain hairband, ribbon or scrunchy matching the school colours, if it is long enough to do so.
- Brightly coloured, dyed hair and excessive hair accessories are not considered appropriate.

Jewellery

Pupils may wear a sensible watch and stud earrings. No other jewellery is permitted apart from for religious reasons, which the Head Teacher will need to be consulted on. Watches and earrings must be removed before PE activities. If a pupil is unable to remove their own earrings, parents should remove their child's earrings before school on days when the child has PE lessons. Earrings may be covered with medical tape in cases when they cannot be removed.

Footwear

Black shoes or plain black trainer shoes should be worn for school. Sports trainers and boots are not permitted in class but may be worn at break times.

Clothing for P.E

Pupils should wear black shorts and their house coloured t-shirt to participate in PE lesson (Saint Davids – Yellow/Saint Andrews – Blue/Saint Patricks – Green/Saint Georges – Red). During the winter months, all pupils require trainers and suitable outdoor clothing (black jogging bottoms/leggings and their school cardigan, jumper or sweatshirt) in addition to shorts and t-shirt.

School Bags

School book bags with the school logo are optional. An appropriately sized backpack can be used.

School Uniform

- Grey skirt/pinafore or trousers/shorts.
- Summer Uniform green and white checked dress
- Bottle green cardigan, jumper or sweatshirt (with or without logo)
- White polo shirt or shirt with collar.
- Hair Accessories (black, green or white)
- Black, grey or white socks or tights.
- Black shoes

PE Kit

- Black shorts
- House coloured t-Ssirt (with or without logo)
- Black jogging bottoms/leggings
- Trainers
- Bottle green school cardigan, jumper or sweatshirt
