Maths:
Compare numbers
Collect a selection of up to 20 objects from around the house or in the garden.
(small toys, books, stones or pebbles, pasta shapes, etc)
 Put some of the objects into a line on the floor.
 Count the objects from left to right. Jump along the line of objects as you count
them.
 Now jump back along the line right to left, counting backwards from the total number back to 1.
Leave that line of objects set out and make a new line of objects and repeat.
 Now tell your helper which of the two lines has more, and which line has fewer.
Complete the sentences:
"This line has objects. This line has objects.
is more than is less than"
 How many more, or less, is it?
