# Science: Everyday Materials

**materials** anything used for building or making something else.

**brick** a small, hard block usually made of clay, concrete, or stone.

**natural** a material that comes from animals, plants or the Earth.

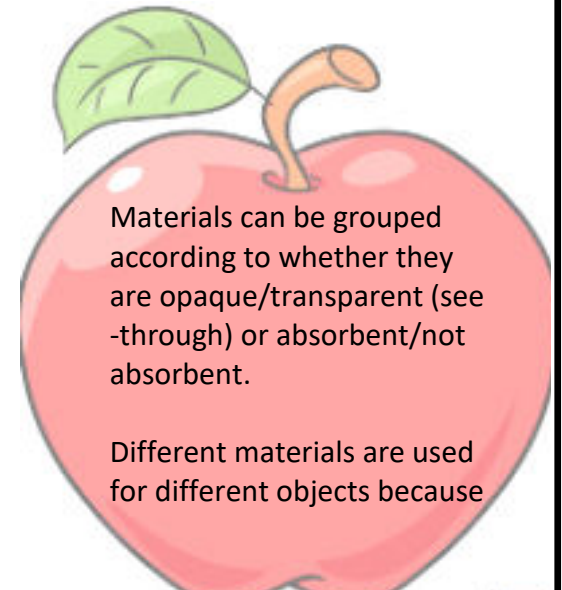
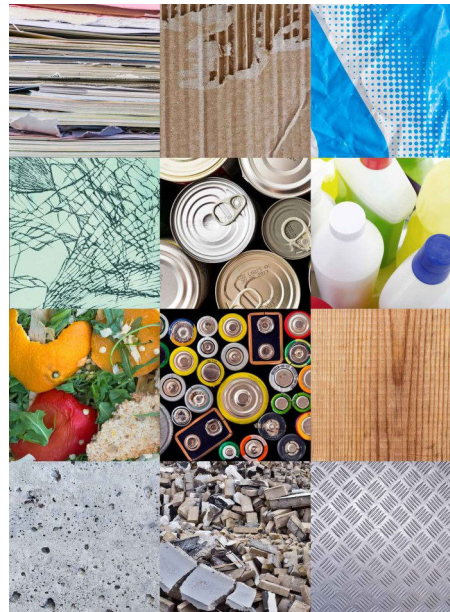
**man-made** a material made by humans

**physical change** when something changes how it looks, feels, or behaves, but it's still the same material.

**suitability** the quality of having the features that are right for a specific purpose.

**absorbent** something that can soak up liquid easily

**seethrough** look right through something because it is clear or very thin .



Materials can be grouped according to whether they are opaque/transparent (see -through) or absorbent/not absorbent.
