- **Texture** In music, texture refers to how many layers of sound are heard at once, and how they interact (for example, melody and harmony playing together).
- Ternary Form A musical structure with three parts: A–B–A, where the first and last sections are the same, and the middle section is different.
- **Drone** A long, continuous note or sound that stays the same while other music plays over it.
