landmark	A structure that is easily recognised.
human feature	Something made/built by a human.
physical feature	Things that occur naturally like seas, mountains, hills, valleys and rivers.

- Physical features are parts of a landscape which are natural and not made by humans.



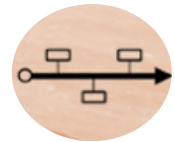

racism	When people are treated unfairly because of their skin colour or background.

equality	The right of every person to receive equal treatment and opportunities.
heritage	Something that comes from ones family or culture.
