English

Can you write a diary entry about your weekend? Bring it in and read it to your class! Remember what we have learnt about sentence structure! A sentence starts with a capital letter and ends with a full stop. You should use your phonic knowledge to sound out your words and also read your sentence back to make sure it makes sense.



Maths

Compare numbers

Collect a selection of up to 20 objects from around the house or in the garden.

(small toys, books, stones or pebbles, pasta shapes, etc)

- Put some of the objects into a line on the floor.
- Count the objects from left to right. Jump along the line of objects as you count them.
- Now jump back along the line right to left, counting backwards from the total number back to 1.
- Leave that line of objects set out and make a new line of objects and repeat.
- Now tell your helper which of the two lines has more, and which line has fewer.
- Complete the sentences:
"This line has ___ objects. This line has ___ objects.
___ is more than ___. ___ is less than ___."
- How many more, or less, is it?

Challenge:

Can you make two lines with the same number of objects in each?

This term we are continuing to look at maps. Can you draw a map of somewhere you like to visit, labelling it with some human and physical features?

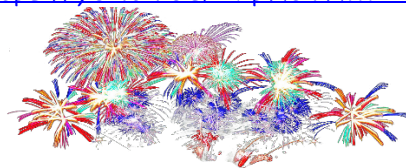


History
