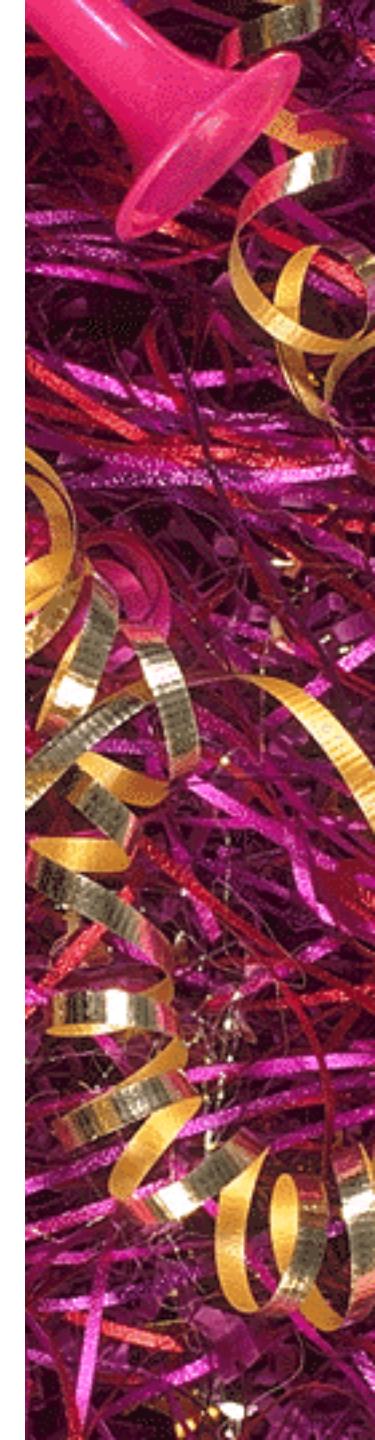
A special thank you to our school choir who sang some great Christmas favourite songs!
