


## Term 3 – Home Learning – Year 1

<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Learn and sing the nursery rhymes about The Great Fire of London e.g London Bridge is falling down, London's Burning.</p> 	<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Paint a scene of The Great Fire of London. Can you write about your scene using adjectives to describe your picture?</p> <p>Take a trip to London, can you find where the Great Fire of London started? Write about your trip to share with your class.</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>Create a poster warning of the dangers of fire and how to stay safe.</p> <p>This term, our focus in PSHE is 'Dreams and Goals'. Can you create a poster of what you want to be when you grow up and explain why this is your goal?</p> 
<p><b>DT</b></p> <p>Research and find a recipe for bread. Can you bake some bread?</p> 	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Create a display of animals that are herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. Can you include what they eat?</p>	<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>Research African prints and artists. Create your own African print at home.</p>
<p><b>Phonics</b></p> <p>Can you create a list of words using the split digraphs:</p> <p>a_e e_e u_e i_e o_e</p> <p>Practice the following tricky words so you recognise them every time!</p> <p>their people your could want</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Find some games that use numbers to play them, ie snakes and ladders, can you recognise all the numbers.</p> <p>Make your own number flashcards (0-20) Can you put them in the right order?</p> <p>Using your flashcards, can you create your own addition and subtraction maths sentences.</p> <p>Practice counting in 2's, how far can you count up to?</p>	<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>Can you write a prayer thanking God for the good news that Jesus brought to Christians?</p>
