Make sure you include the plants and the animals.</p> 
<p>Create a map of your house. Hide some 'treasure' and see if someone can follow your map and find it!</p>	<p>Create a poster about why we need to save our rainforests from deforestation. Include what we can do to help.</p>	<p>Choose a country in the UK to find out about. Where would you like to live in the UK and why?</p>
<p>Can you find out about a toy from the past? What year was it from? Bring it in and show the class.</p> 	<p>Practise counting up in your 2s, 5s and 10s. Can you find some 2p, 5p and 10p coins and use them to count.</p> 	<p>Research the 4 layers of the Rainforest.
