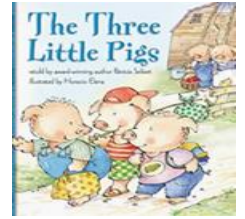

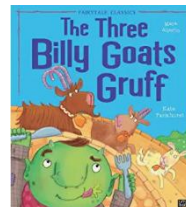


Sticky Knowledge

- Traditional tales are stories that have been told to children for hundreds of years.
- Many traditional tales are set in woodlands and forests and often include animals as main characters.
- Fairy tales are fantasy stories with imaginary beings and magical settings.
- Many fairy tales are set in castles and often include royal characters like kings or princesses.
- Stories, books and pictures are used to help people find out about events in the past and people who lived in the past.
- Kings, queens, princes and princesses are part of royal families, the United Kingdom has a royal family.

fairy tale – a magical story for children.

moral – a moral of a story is the message that the story is teaching you. This is normally about important values such as kindness, honesty and empathy.
