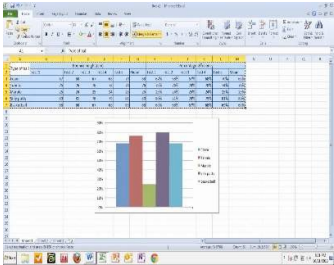






Home Learning Term 6
